Once widespread throughout central Cape York QLD Australia, the spectacular Golden-shouldered Parrot is now isolated to a few small areas with total numbers estimated at 2000 birds. These breathtakingly beautiful Parrots can't be seen anywhere else in the world making them endemic to the Cape York area.

The Shephard family from Artemis station have a population of approximately 300 birds on their property and have been involved in their conservation for many years. With your help and support we can try to prevent the Golden-shouldered Parrot from following the same fate as its relative the now extinct Paradise Parrot.
